Day One	
Time	Topics
9:00am – 10:30am	<p>All is about the Brain</p> <p>The brain is a wonderful organ; it starts working when you get up in the morning and does not stop until you get into the office. In the module, the participants would learn the impact of the emotional brain, instinctual brain, logical brain, conscious and subconscious mind, innies, and outies. Then, the participants would learn the concept of personality and observational science, the fundamentals of Enneagram Symbol, personality, and neuroscience.</p>
10:30am – 11:00am	Tea Break and Networking
11:00am – 1:00pm	<p>Secret of Prosperity</p> <p>To prosper, you must love yourself by being humble and teachable. The participants would learn how to start to have self-love. The participants will understand and practice emotional, instinctual, and logical into one. This chapter prepares the mind of a leader to take up the journey as a hero, and the participants are reminded to stay humble. The participants would learn three steps to philautic leadership that focus on policy, procedure, and practice.</p>
1:00pm – 2:00pm	Lunch and Networking
2:00pm – 3:30pm	<p>Love You Like My Family</p> <p>To be a successful leader, this module shares with the participants the Play principle to win by treating everyone like family. First, the participants would learn the ludus love - the type of love that is often exhibited between close family members and children while playing. Next, the participants would learn the skills through role-playing. Finally, participants would convert ludus love into policy, procedure, and practice in the practical session.</p>
3:30pm – 4:00pm	Tea Break and Networking
4:00pm- 5:00pm	<p>Generosity: Give not to Receive, but Only to Fill Your Heart with Joy</p> <p>The participants would learn the emotional fulfilment when a person gives. The participants would learn how to apply Agape love - unconditional love, which requires loving without expectations. We must love the people we lead and serve as an example of how they should love each other. Generosity will be adopted into policy, procedure, and practice.</p>
Day Two	
Time	Topics

9:00am – 10:30am	<p>The Power of Passion: Unbreakable Love</p> <p>Without passion and purpose, you are a ship without a rudder. Therefore, the participants would learn how to cultivate passion at work in this module. After understanding the principle, the participants need to integrate passion into the company policy, procedure and practice.</p>
10:30am – 11:00am	Tea Break and Networking
11:00am – 1:00pm	<p>Courage: The Key of Integrity and Accountability</p> <p>The participants would appreciate the courage to speak and act freely when appropriate between peers, subordinates, and superiors without fear of ridicule or reprimands. The participants would pick up the listening skills and constantly be reminded of the concept of fairness when integrating policy, procedure, and practice.</p>
1:00pm – 2:00pm	Lunch and Networking
2:00pm – 3:30pm	<p>Authority: Play like Flying a Kite</p> <p>Tough love leaders are authoritative mentors, not authoritarian dictators. The “tough love” is difficult but necessary to help others learn and grow. At the end of this module, participants should become confident, authoritative leaders rather than a “dictators” authoritarian. The tough love would be integrated into policy, procedure, and practice.</p>
3:30pm – 4:00pm	Tea Break and Networking
4:00pm- 5:00pm	<p>Patience and Dependability</p> <p>Patience and dependability are the cornerstones of outstanding leadership. Participants would understand that to gain wisdom requires patience, experience, and the willingness to listen to input from others. Therefore, the participants would practice patience and dependability are the cornerstones of outstanding leadership. The principle is integrated into policy, procedure, and practice.</p>
