Time	Day One
9.00am – 10.30am	Understand the Concepts of Nonverbal Communication In this module, participants would learn the fundamentals of nonverbal communication, the evolution of body language, the role and function of nonverbal communication and basic principles to understand the concepts.

11.00am-1.00pm	Understand the Concepts of Nonverbal Communication Participants would learn a method to set objectives before conducting the nonverbal analysis. In this module, participants would learn the principle such as context, consistency, baselining and congruence would be introduced in this module.

2.00pm-3.30pm	<p>Unravelling an Enigma: Facial Expressions</p> <p>This module helps you to understand the type of facial expression, forehead, eyebrow, chin and lips. The different regions of facial expression give various tips to reach the heart of a person.</p>

4.00pm-5.00pm	<p>Unravelling an Enigma: Facial Expressions</p> <p>Participants would learn the fundamentals of Facial Action Coding System (FACS) to analyse facial expression. The participant would have fundamental knowledge of how FACS works and understand the basic reporting system of FACS.</p>

9.00am – 10.30am	<p>Touch – A Bonding Interaction</p> <p>In this module, participants would learn the various types of tactile contact, touching behaviour. The concept in tactile contact includes self-touch and is shared in this module.</p>

11.00am-12.00pm	<p>Touch – A Bonding Interaction</p> <p>Participants would be exposed to the various intensity of touch, and different case studies are exposed to the candidate to enhance their skills in observing human touch.</p>
